Our Lady of the Valley News

Stained Glass Window Project & Church Acoustics.

We are happy to announce that we are finally moving forward with both our Stained Glass Window and Acoustic Projects. Two weeks ago there was a meeting called by Fr. Saji with both the Parish and Finance Council members to explain what would be done in the Church, the benefits of having the Acoustics set up to intake the echo being created in the Church as our sound system seems to be in perfect working condition, how long the project would take and the cost for it all. After explaining and answering questions both the Parish and Finance Council members came to an agreement and voted to move forward with this project. A letter has been sent to the Diocese and we are currently waiting for their approval so we can start setting dates for this project to take place. According to the information we received from Ted Brown Music the project will take about a week to complete.

Stained Glass Window Project

We received confirmation from Tim Hudson and the company that is being hired to restore our Stained Glass Windows that they had received their insurance or CCB number from the state of Oregon. This project had been put on hold for over a year do to the fact that the Diocese of Baker was requiring them to have a CCB number for the state of Oregon and Tim Hudson was waiting on the state for approval. They are the larges company in the country and they have CCB number for our surrounding states except for Oregon until now. The information received was sent to the Diocese of Baker for approval and we have been given Bishops blessing to move forward with this project. As time goes we will continue to keep everyone up-to-date, in the meantime if you have any questions or would like more information please call or email the office.
