The La Grande Farmers Market has a program that allows Snap/EBT (Oregon Trail Card/Food Stamp) cardholders to use their food money at the Market. For every \$10 spent with their EBT card, the Farmers market will give them an extra \$10 to spend at the Market on Fresh fruit and vegetables. This can be used on both Tuesdays and Saturdays. And for the month of August only this amount will be increased, for every \$20 spent with their EBT card they will receive \$20 to spend at the Market.
