<u>The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ</u> (Corpus Christi)

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ, the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. At every Mass our at-

tention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others. St. John Paul II

encouraged Adoration. In Dominicae cenae, he expressed: "The Church and world have a great need for Eucharistic worship. Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love. Let us not refuse the time to go to meet Him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offenses and crimes of the world. Let our adoration never cease."

Some benefits fo Eucharistic Adoration; 1.Every Holy Hour we make so pleases the heart of Jesus that it is recorded in Heaven and retold for all eternity! (St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta)

2. The spiritual lives of our families are strengthened through our Holy Hour. (St. John Paul II) 3. Our Lord hears our prayers anywhere, but He has revealed to His servants that those who visit Him in the Eucharist will obtain a more abundant measure of grace. (St. Alphonsus Ligouri) A Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament is worth more than a thousand years

of human glory. (St. Padre Pio) At the moment we have 2 Adoration hours available on Tuesdays; one hour is from 1:00 pm—2:00 pm and the second hour is from 5:00 pm—6:00 pm. For more Information please contact Mary Calder.
