Knowing the Saints: St John XIII

Reading about St. John XXIII will tell you the story of a man who came from a large Catholic farm family, a man who is often described as very ordinary and humble. When he was elected pope, it was expected that he would hold the Chair of Peter for a short time and act as a custodian of the Church — maintaining and not innovating. Yet this same man is the man whose openness to the leading of the Holy Spirit resulted in the Second Vatican Council. It may be a surprise that the same pope who called for Vatican II said, "Before everything else, fidelity to the Church: One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic. Jesus did not found several churches, but one single Church." His feast day is October 11,

<u>Get FORMED — St. John XXIII</u>

Starring Edward Asner, as the beloved pontiff, Saint Pope John XXIII, tells the whole life story of the pope from his youth through his young priesthood, episcopacy, life as cardinal, and eventually his life as Pope. It shows his simplicity, goodness, courage and love for humanity. Elected as an "interim Pope" who would just keep the status quo and listen to the advisers around him, John XXIII proved to be his own man when he surprised the Church and world by calling for the Second Vatican Council. This film also underscores his wonderful sense of humor and great charity towards others, especially the poor, downtrodden, and the outcast. You may also be interested in **Revolution of John XXIII**. This documentary by Rome Reports describes Vatican II. When the Cardinals elected the Pope, they were hoping for an uneventful pontificate without surprises. Instead the got Vatican II, in which John XXIII launched the greatest revolution in the modern history of the Catholic Church.
