

Celebrating the Saints: St. Antony of Padua Many people have been introduced to St. Anthony as the patron saint of lost things: "Tony, Tony, turn around, something's lost and must be found." The incident that gave rise to rooted in his concern for the loss of a vocation. In 1224, St. Francis of Assisi had assigned the friars' studies to St. Anthony. He had a book of notes that he had compiled to help him teach. One novice decided to leave the order and when he left, he stole this book. When St. Anthony found out, he, of course, wanted his book back, but what he really prayed for was for the young man to recover his vocation. In the end, the novice returned and brought the book with him. During his life, he was renowned as a preacher and was assigned to preach to heretics. It is said that at one point when the heretics refused to listen to him, he preached to fish and thousands of fish came to the surface of the water to hear him, and this was a wake up call to those who had refused to listen. In our lives, St. Anthony is an example of someone who has found God and turned his life over to him. His feast is June 13. Take a minute to ask him to help you find one thing you can do to deepen your relationship with our Lord and then the strength to do it.
