FORMED: Pick of the Week **Feminine Genius**

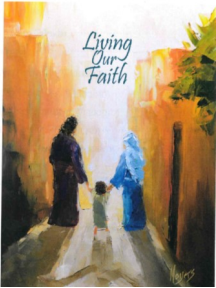
