Ash Wednesday is a day of **fasting and abstinence.** Fasting is **obligatory** from

age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat **one full meal, as well as two smaller meals** that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence from meat is obligatory from **age 14 on**.
