This Wednesday, February 26 is Ash Wednesday. Mass with the distribution of ashes will be available at 8 am & 7 pm.



Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and **abstinence.** Fasting is **obligatory** from

age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence from meat is obligatory from age 14 on.




