Lenten Penance Service

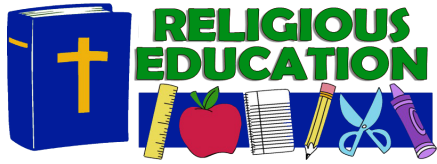

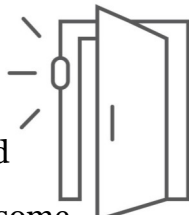


Celebration of Life—Fred VanSlyke

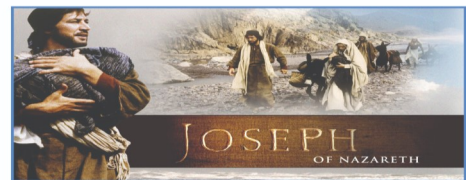
