Vatican Exhibit of Sacred Relics

Our Lady of the Valley

June 4th, 2021
6:00 PM

The Diocese of Baker presents a teaching and exposition of an extraordinary Vatican collection of Sacred Relics from Thursday, June 3, 2021 through Wednesday June 9, 2021. Over 150 relics will be present, some as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of the Twelves Apostles, St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have occurred in the presence of relics, and many have happened through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
