Father's Day is celebrated on the third Sunday of June in the United States. I wish all fathers, *Happy Father's Day!* This is a day to honor and express our gratitude and love to all fathers for their service and care of their families and society at large. Father's Day has been celebrated on March 19th in Catholic countries throughout Europe beginning in the Middle Ages. March 19th is the Feast Day of St. Joseph, the foster father of Jesus. - 7) *A father in the shadows.*

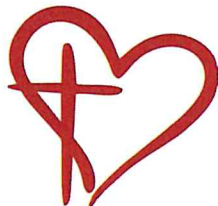
As we celebrate Father's Day let us reflect and meditate on all these qualities of St. Joseph and imbibe this spirit in our life.
