Official Announcement from Bp. Cary

On Friday June 25th Governor Kate Brown announced that the COVID-19 restrictions will end when the state achieves a 70% first dose adult vaccination rate, or on Wednesday, June 30, whichever comes first.

In light of this development, I hereby withdraw the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. The obligation to attend mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is to be reinstated in the Diocese of Baker on the weekend of July 3-4, 2021. The ordinary exceptions under the obligation prior to the dispensation remain. Feel free to take any questions you might have to your pastor.
