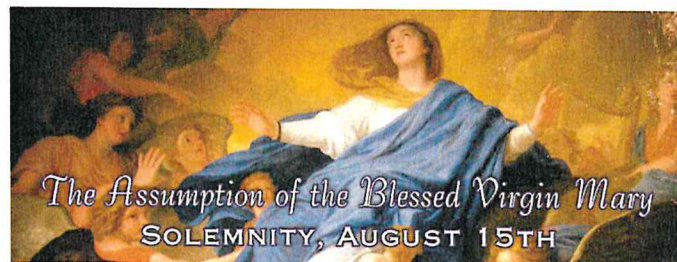

**Saint of the Week**

St. Helena, Feast Day: August 18th  
Patroness of New Discoveries

The mother of the Emperor Constantine the Great, the Roman Emperor who legalized Christianity in 312AD, Helena played a pivotal role in his conversion. She is credited with the discovery of the True Cross, the Titulus Crucis (the plaque Pilate had affixed to the Cross when Jesus was crucified), Nails of the Crucifixion, the Crown of Thorns and the Holy Stairs that Jesus climbed to the palace of Pilate when He was condemned to death and that can still be climbed today by the faithful on special occasions in Rome.
