Saint of the Week St. Gregory the Great, Feast Day: September 3rd Pope and Doctor of the Church

C. 540AD – March 12, 604AD

Gregory was content to be a monk, but he willingly served the Church in other ways when asked. He sacri-

ficed his own preferences in many ways, especially when he was called to be Bishop of Rome. Once he was called to public service, Gregory gave his considerable energies completely to this work. Gregory's description of bishops as physicians fits in well with Pope Francis'

description of the Church as a "field hospital."
