UNDERTSTANDING THE MASS What is the Collect?

The "collect" also known as the Opening Prayer is a prayer that concludes the opening rites of the Mass. The collect invites people to pray in silence for a moment, and then offers a prayer to God that is based on the readings or feast of the day, or the purpose for which the Mass is being offered. We respond "Amen" which is Hebrew for "so be it." This opening prayer takes all of our individual needs and focuses them, collects them into a common purpose for celebrating that day's Mass.
