What does the word "purgatory" mean? "The concept of Purgatory can be a strange one for many to accept, as it can seem like a middle place, between Heaven and Hell," writes Philip Kosloski. "Yet, in reality, Purgatory is much more related to Heaven, and its name helps explain what happens in this stage of the afterlife." The English word purgatory comes from the Latin purgare, "to make clean, to purify." It is a place of final purification before a soul reaches the gates of Heaven.
