Applications for this year's Thanksgiving baskets are now available.

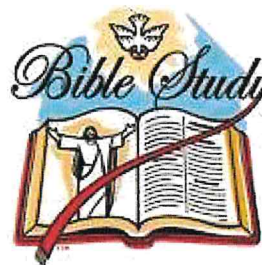
