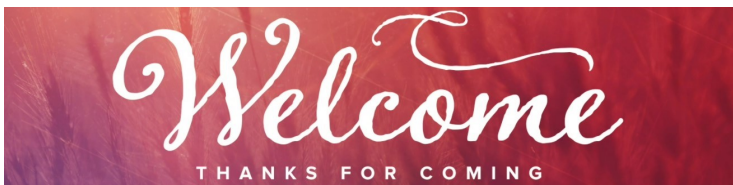

Catholic School Enrollment is Up!

The National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) announced Monday that Catholic school enrollment increased by 62,000 students, representing a 3.8% jump. Catholic school enrollment decreased by 6.4% in 2020, its largest one-year decline since NCEA began collecting the data. A NCEA brief report credited the enrollment bump this year to Catholic schools' "dedication in safely opening classrooms and supporting their communities' needs."
