

March is the Month of St. Joseph

In Nazareth, the Son of God was subject to St. Joseph as His foster father, and now Christ heeds the petitions of St. Joseph in Heaven. During this month of Saint Joseph, the patron of the Universal Church, we recognize his special interest in the needs of us all, and his intercessory powers and we invite you

to increase your devotion to him.

Why No Flowers During Lent?

Lent is a time of penance and introspection. It is based on Jesus' 40 days in the desert overcoming temptation. Catholic churches reflect this dry period by prohibiting festive decorations and floral arrangements in the church leading up to the Easter Triduum. This is also why there are no weddings or baptisms during the Lenten period. However, on Laetare Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent, when the Church expresses a glimpse of the joy that awaits us at Easter, simple arrangements are permitted. On Holy Thursday, the altar is barren again but the Altar of Repose, where the Holy Eucharist will reside, in the Marian Chapel, will be highly decorated . The church becomes glorious again for Easter Vigil and will stay that way through Pentecost.
