

In a letter to the pope, the Ukrainian bishops said that they were writing "in these hours of immeas-urable pain and terrible ordeal for our people" in response to many requests for the consecration. "Responding to this prayer, we humbly ask Your Holiness to publicly perform the act of consecra-tion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Ukraine and Russia, as requested by the Blessed Virgin in Fatima," said the letter, published on the bishops' website on Ash Wednesday, March 2.
