Synod on SynodalityBishop Cary invites all the parishioners of the Diocese to participate in the worldwide Synod on Synodality. On Sunday, October 10th, 2021, Pope Francis opened the 2021-2023 Synod at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. This Synod begins a two-year process of

listening and dialogue. The theme for this synod is, "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission." It will conclude with an international gathering of bishops in Rome in the fall of 2023. This interna-

tional synod is about a journey of sharing, reflecting and listening on all levels across the Church.

Pope Francis said, "the purpose of this Synod is not to produce documents, but to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, give strength to our hands." (Preparatory Document, #32)

Please share your thoughts so that the Church may discern, with the help of the Holy Spirit, how to improve on meeting the needs of all the faithful. If you know of any family or friends who have left the Church, we want to hear their voices as well! In order for the future of the Church to look bright, Pope Francis wants to ensure that the leaders of the Church consult with all

levels of Christ's body so that a true spirit of "synodality" (walking together) is at work in the decision-making process, looking forward to the mission in front of us. An insert with the questions for discussion for the Synod is included in the parish bulletin this weekend, in both English and Spanish. Don't miss out on this opportunity to share your ideas with the magisterium of the Church!

If people wish to gather and discuss the questions together, Fr. Saji will make the Conference Room available on Wednesday, July 6th at 6:00pm if people would like to meet as a group.

The Diocese is working on a tight schedule and the results need to be sent to the USCCB no later than August 15th. For our part, we need to return our forms to

the Parish Office by Sunday, June 26th They can be delivered either directly to the office or be put into the locked box on the Office door in the hallway. For those of you who have a current email address in our Parish Registry, the questionnaire will be sent to you through ParishSoft to make filling out the form easier. All responses will remain anonymous if you wish. From there the answers will be tabulated and sent to the Dean of our Deanery, who will prepare a report to be sent to the Vicar General, who will then compile the report and present it to Bp. Cary who will forward it to the USCCB.
