U.S. Catholic Sisters Against Human Trafficking

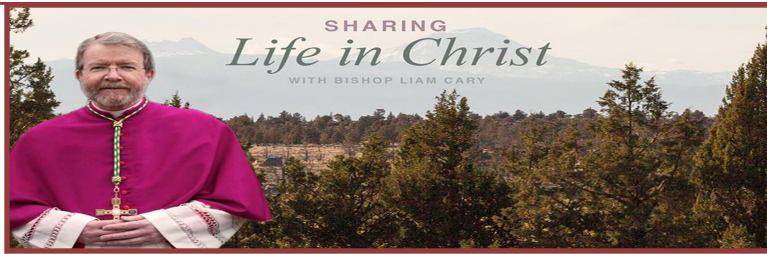

If one day illness touches my mind and clouds it, I do surrender to You now, with a devotion that will later be continued in silent adoration.

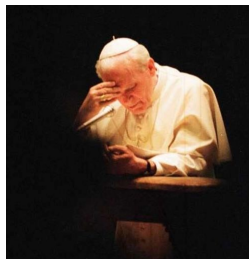
