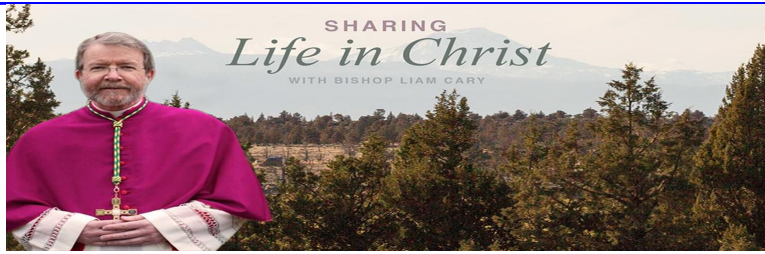

Dear La Grande—Our Lady of the Valley,
 In recent surveys of religious preference, participants commonly leave unchecked the box for “Catholic” or “Protestant” or “Jew” and select instead “None of the Above.”

To be a “none,” to refuse to identify religiously, I need only say what I don’t believe; nobody asks me to confess what I do believe.

What if they did? What if, as a “none,” I had to subject my unquestioned, privately-held beliefs to the hostile public derision Christians face? How well could I defend my view of the world and of myself within it in the face of fierce opposition? How would I hold up with no one to back me up?

My purely personal creed links me intellectually to no one else. “Nones” have no regular, recurring occasion to articulate their individualized beliefs publicly with other “nones” in depth and detail. Therefore, I seldom if ever need to articulate my world of meaning before others or defend it publicly. No one challenges me; no one calls me out for inconsistencies and contradictions. I stand beyond confrontation, alone and uncorrectable, to decide for myself what the world’s all about.

How can I be confident that my life is heading in the right direction if I keep myself at a distance from wiser voices than mine that call for course correction?

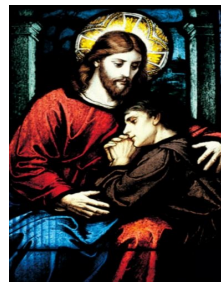
