Holiday Bazaar



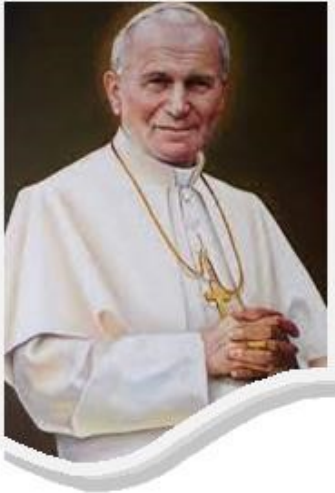
Holiday Bazaar **November 19th**

Feast Day

The life of a saint is one in which the Gospel is luminous. In this way, the Church has received an inestimable gift in St. John Paul II.

Through his life, he has shown the radiation of the fatherhood of God in humanity, or what St. Paul calls the "newness of life in Christ".

According to the church, John Paul performed his first miracle on a French nun with Parkinson's disease in June 2005, several months after he died. He performed the second miracle on a Costa Rican woman with an aneurism in 2011, six years after his death. Pope John Paul is remembered for his successful efforts to end communism. As well as for building bridges with peoples of other faiths.
