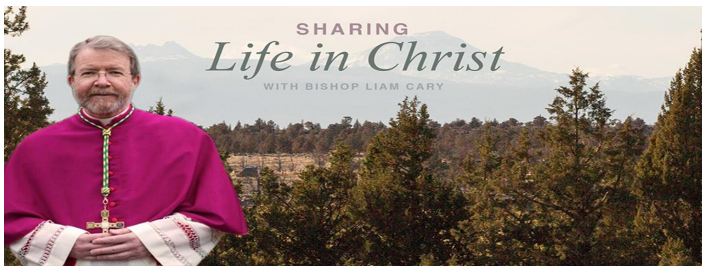


Holiday Bazaar
