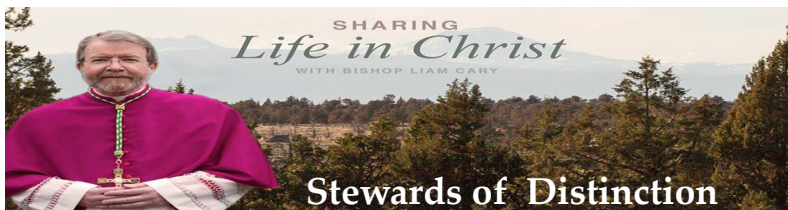


Resumption of the Precious Blood of Christ
