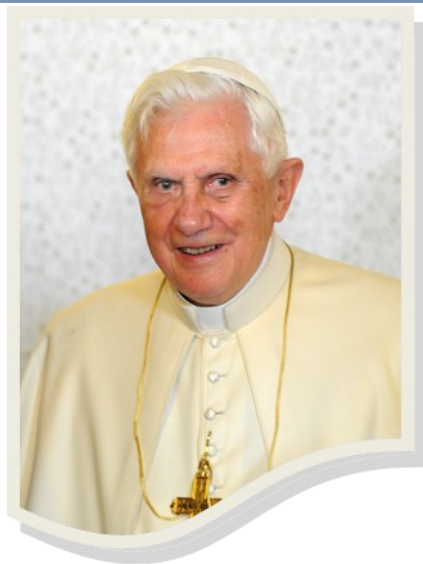

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI

May the soul of Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

In 1986, St. John Paul II appointed then-Cardinal Ratzinger to lead the development of the new *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. It was a monumental task!

He wrote, "I must confess that even today it seems to me a miracle that this project [the *Catechism*] was finally successful."

He also wrote:

...Some people tell me that *Catechism* doesn't interest today's youth; but I don't believe this statement and I'm sure I'm right . It is not as superficial as it is accused of being; young people want to know what ... which could also be ours; this book is compelling because it tells us about our own destiny and therefore concerns each of us closely. For this I invite you: study the *catechism*! This is my heartfelt wish .

As we begin our *Catechism in a Year* journey together, please remember in your prayers a man to whom we are all indebted in a particular way for this gift: Pope Benedict XVI.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O God, and may perpetual light shine upon him.
