## Lenten Regulations

**Abstinence:** Meat and poultry are removed from our meals, but fish is acceptable.

**Fasting:** Eat one full meal and two smaller meals, and no snacking during the day.

All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

All Catholics 14 years and older are to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.
