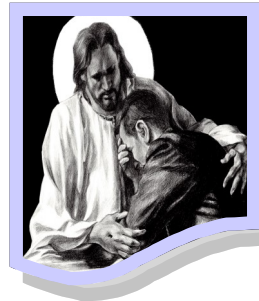

## Eucharistic Procession

Immediately following communion on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, there will be a Eucharistic Procession to celebrate Christ's presence in the Eucharist. The procession route will be around the church property, south on 5<sup>th</sup> Street, West on "K" Avenue and north on 4<sup>th</sup> Street. The procession will return to the interior of the church for the final blessing. People who are unable to walk the route can stay in the church for the final blessing.

In his Homily on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, June 6, 2021, Pope Frances shared the following with us: *"The procession of the Blessed Sacrament...reminds us that we are called to go out and bring Jesus to others. To go out with enthusiasm, bringing Christ to those we meet in our daily lives."*

This *Eucharistic Procession* is a way for us to express and publicly profess our faith in our belief that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. Consider this to be a personal invitation to take part in this in this expression of faith. Also, prayerfully consider being involved in the planning and successful implementation of this event, as there are many opportunities to help with this very special event.
