All Saints Day

All Souls Day

November 2nd is All Souls Day — the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed. On this day we remember and pray for all those who have died. We believe that our love relationship with God endures for all eternity, with God always ready to welcome and embrace us. We also believe that death does not separate the living from those who have died. Just as we ask each other for prayers during our lifetime, we continue that practice even beyond death. If you do not receive Church envelopes, there are envelopes in the pews and on the small table as you enter the church, to commemorate someone on this special day through arranging a Mass for the repose of their soul.

How to Request a Mass

All Souls Day reminds us of the importance of having a Mass offered for the repose of the souls of our deceased loved ones.

To request a Mass for a deceased loved one, fill out one of the envelopes provided in the pews or on the <u>little table as you enter the church.</u> Drop it in the collection basket or bring it to the Parish Office and a Mass will be scheduled as per your request and announced in the bulletin in the *Weekly Events* section.

A Special Announcement

For those who request a Mass for a deceased loved one through the Office or by dropping their Mass Request envelope in the collection basket

before Wednesday, November 1st (All Saints Day), the name of that loved one will be read at the 7:00pm Mass (on All Saints Day) as an extra remembrance during a candle lighting ceremony which will take place during the Mass. Your requested Mass will also be scheduled on Father's calendar to take place sometime during the weeks following All Soul's Day, but the reading of the names on All Saints Day is an additional way for friends and relatives to be remembered and prayed for at a Mass.
