Advent Reconciliation Service

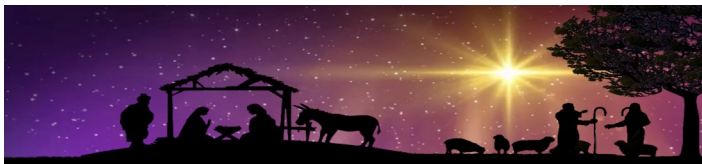
