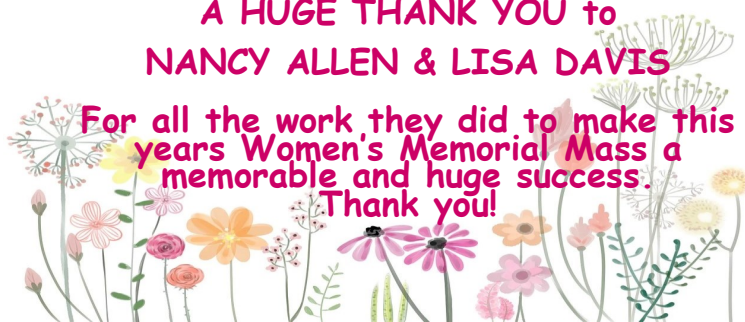
### 2025 Bishop's Annual Appeal
