## Bishop Elect Fr. Thomas Hennen

Pope Leo XIV has accepted the resignation of Bishop Liam Cary and has appointed Father Thomas Hennen a priest from the Diocese of Davenport and current Vicar General and rector of Sacred Heart Cathedral in Davenport, Iowa.

Father Hennen was born on July 4, 1978, in Ottumwa, Iowa. Bishop-elect Hennen pursued studies at Saint Ambrose University in Davenport. He also studied at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, and the Pontifical Gregorian University, earning a bachelor's in sacred theology (2005) from the Pontifical Alphonsian Academy in Rome. Father Hennen was ordained to the priesthood on July 10, 2004. Bishop-elect Hennen speaks English, Spanish and Italian. The Episcopal Ordination is scheduled for Monday Sept. 29th in Bend.
